SENIORS INFORMATION VICTORIA

A service that offers free information on a wide range of issues of interest to older Victorians including housing, health and wellbeing, general information on legal and financial matters, retirement and maintaining social connections.

SPEAKERS AND COMMUNITY EDUCATION

Information sessions and programs for older people, including Challenging Ageing, Retirement planning programmes and information sessions on Quality Use of Medicines, beyond maturity blues and Ageing Well.

SENIORS RIGHTS VICTORIA

A service addressing issues of abuse of older people, providing information, referral, access to lawyers and advocates and community education. This service is funded by the Victorian Government and Victorian Legal Aid. It is managed in partnership with PILCH, Loddon Campaspe and Eastern Community Legal Centres.

ACTIVE AGEING

We work to develop and promote accessible sport and recreation opportunities for older people, which meet the national health guidelines, providing strength, huff and puff and flexibility outcomes. We also work to achieve Age Friendly Communities, as developed under the WHO, working with all governments, organisations and older people to achieve this. Our present programmes include: promotion of strength training through Living Longer Living Stronger, COTA Cyclers and the Active Ageing Network in partnership with the YMCA.

SENIORS VOICE IN ACTION

We consult with older people and advise government, service providers and corporate organisations on the issues of importance to older people, including housing, income security, transport, service providers and age friendly environments.
